Sleeping scenarios at the touch of a button

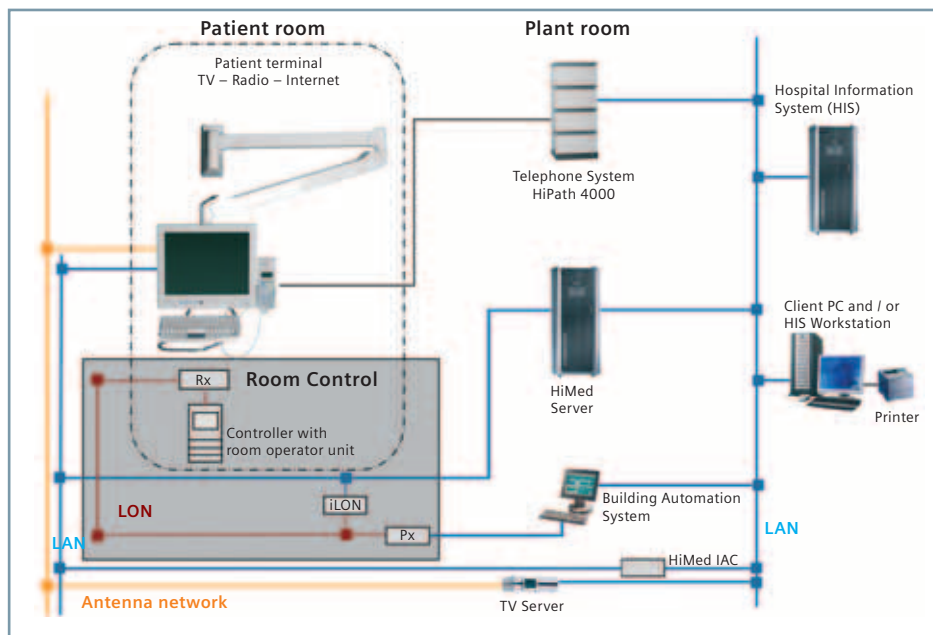
By pressing a button on the multimedia terminal touchpanel, lights are switched off, blinds lowered, the telephone can be

redirected to the voice mail system and the nurse call system displays "Please do not disturb". The scenario can be extended by extra functions, such as room temperature adjustment, automatic opening/closing of windows or silent music.
